1. Challenge in the present petition is to the order of eviction dated 01.06.1999 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2 and the appellate order dated 20.03.2001 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.3.
2. Vide order dated 05.01.2024, Registry was directed to inform the parties/counsel regarding the next date of hearing.
3. It has been reported by the Registry that Mr. Manohar Kumar Garg, Mr. Anil Kumar Walia, Mr. Anoop Singla, Mr. R.K. Girdhar, Advocates and the office of Advocate General Punjab, have already been informed through email. Notices were also issued to petitioners. While petitioner No.1 was not found residing at the given address, petitioner No.2 is stated to have died. Notices issued to respondents No.1 and 2 have been

served and notice issued to respondent No.3 has not been received back served or otherwise.

4. It seems that the petitioners are no more traceable and they may not be interested in pursuing the present petition any further after a period of more than two decades.

5. The present writ petition is accordingly **disposed of**.

6. Liberty is however granted to the petitioners to seek revival of the present petition within a period of six months, if any such issue still survives.

7. All other civil misc. applications, if any, stands disposed of.
