1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC. seeking quashing of FIR No.194 dated 18.11.2019 under Sections 498-A/406 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the complainant/respondent No.2 has complied with the settlement and has appeared before the jurisdictional Court to record his statement in terms of the compromise. However, petitioner No.3 is not coming forward to perform his undertaking as per settlement by appearing before the Family Court to file the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 seeking dissolution of marriage by way of mutual consent.

3. As such, learned counsel for respondent No.2 has clear instructions to withdraw the consent for quashing of the FIR (supra) on the basis of the compromise.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the petition with liberty to file the fresh petition, in case, any compromise is effected between the parties in near future.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
