Prayer in the present petition is for directing the official respondents to provide the police help so that the wheat crop sown by the petitioners could be harvested and also to take action against respondents No.4 to 13 who are not allowing the petitioners to harvest their standing wheat crop and are threatening to kill petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are owners in possession of the land in question and as such, they are legally entitle to harvest the wheat crop standing on the land in question. Notwithstanding, the private respondents are not allowing the petitioners to cut their crops and are threatening them with dire consequences. He further submits that with regard to their grievances, the petitioners have submitted various applications (Annexures P-3 to P-5), however, the police authorities have not taken any action till date.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Harpriya Khaneka, DAG, Punjab accepts notice and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if so advised.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, submits that he would be satisfied at this stage, if Station House Officer, Police Station Mehna, District Moga- respondent No.3 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps in accordance with law

Learned State Counsel has no objection to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the matter, and if need be, to take appropriate steps to maintain law and order, in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
