PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.53 dated 11.08.2022, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 22, 22(c) and 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Kotfatta, District Bathinda.
2. As per the case of the prosecution, on the basis of secret information, recovery of 750 tablets of Tramadol Prolonged release Tablets IP TRAMANAM SR-100 and 950 tablets Tramadol Hydrochloride Tablets 100 mg Trakem-100 were effected from the petitioner on 11.08.2022.
3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no other case pending against the petitioner.
4. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone an actual custody period of more than 01 year 09 months and 03 days.

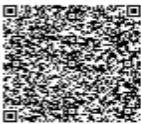
Though, the charges stands framed in November 2023, yet no witness has been examined out of 10 cited witnesses.

5. Counsel for the State does not dispute the aforesaid factual assertions.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the incarceration suffered by the petitioner and the fact that trial is not likely to conclude in the near future, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned. However, in addition to conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, the petitioner shall remain bound by the following conditions :-

- (i) The petitioner shall not mis-use the liberty granted.
- (ii) The petitioner shall not tamper with any evidence oral or documentary during the trial.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not absent himself on any date before the trial.
- (iv) The petitioner shall not commit any offence while on bail.
- (v) The petitioner shall deposit his passport, if any with the trial Court.
- (vi) The petitioner shall give his cellphone number to the police authorities and shall not change his cell-phone number without permission of the trial Court.
- (vii) The petitioner shall not in any manner try to delay the trial.

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7. In case of breach of any of the aforesaid conditions and those which may be imposed by the Trial Court, the prosecution shall be at liberty to move cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
8. Ordered accordingly.
