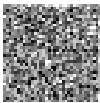

1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the order dated 16.08.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.2 rejecting the claim of the petitioner with a further prayer to direct the respondents to issue matriculation certificate to the petitioner afresh after making due corrections.

2. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the respondents submitted that apparently the impugned order dated 16.08.2023 (Annexure P-6) is not backed by cogent reasons and liberty may be granted to the respondents to pass a fresh order in accordance with law, which will not only be a well reasoned order but



will also be with due application of mind and also in the light of judgment passed by Hon’ble Supreme Court in **Jigya Yadav versus CBSE, 2021 SCC OnLine SC 415**. He further submitted that adequate opportunity of hearing will be granted to the petitioner or his counsel before passing the order.

4. In view of the aforesaid specific statement made by the learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents-CBSE to pass a fresh well reasoned order within a period of two months from today in accordance with law, with due application of mind and backed by reasons and also in the light of judgment passed by Hon’ble Supreme Court in **Jigya Yadav’s case (supra)**, after giving adequate opportunity of hearing to the petitioner or his counsel.
