1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 05.04.2024 passed in CWP-7690-2024.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has produced copy of office order dated 25.04.2024, vide which, the petitioner has been granted suspension allowance, as per rules. Copy of said order is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
