Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.65 dated 03.04.2024, under Section 20(Act No.61 of 1985) of the NDPS Act (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on) registered at Police Station Bass, District Hisar.

Vide order dated 02.05.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 02.05.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 02.05.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
