- By way of instant petition filed under Section 11 (6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short “the Act”), petitioners have approached this Court for appointment of an Arbitrator to adjudicate disputes arising out of work order dated 18.07.2014, Annexure A-1.
- Notice of motion.
- Mr. Ashwani Talwar, Advocate has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Upon instructions received from Mr. Vishal Malhotra, Legal Manager, New India Assurance Co. Ltd., he submits that respondents do not have any objection in case an Arbitraor is appointed by this Court.
