Disposed of with a mandamus upon the Sarpanch of the Panchayat concerned, to in case some encroachments are revealed in a validly conducted demarcation report, to be made on land owned by the Gram Panchayat concerned, thus institute an eviction petition against the encroacher(s) upon such lands. However, it is clarified that if the said encroacher on Panchayat land, is a department of the Government, thereupon, the Sarpanch concerned may consider the passing of a resolution for the transfer of the Panchayat land to the department concerned. On such a resolution becoming passed, it may be considered to be forwarded to the competent approving authority who may lawfully approve the same.
