1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for violating the order dated 16.01.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-782-2023.
2. Short reply dated 08.11.2023 on behalf of respondent No.3 filed in the Registry is taken on record. Learned State counsel has submitted that the order dated 16.01.2023 passed in CWP-782-2023 has been complied with and the bills of the petitioner has been sent to Finance Department for approval and the Finance Department has approved the bills, vide Annexure R-2.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
