1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that respondents No.4 to 6 cheated the petitioners under the guise of an agreement to sell which was executed on 12.12.2012, whereby the private respondents agreed to sell land to the petitioner and in total received Rs. 60 lacs from the petitioners. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that in this regard, the petitioners submitted representation dated 30.06.2023 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 to look in the matter and decide representation dated 30.06.2023 (Annexure P-5) in a given time frame.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1, 2 and 3 and submits that in case any such representation (Annexure P-5) is pending, the same will be considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

4. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 30.06.2023 (Annexure P-5)

in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
