The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 to 5 to take appropriate action against the accused and also directing the respondents to recover the daughter of the petitioner and handed over to him in case bearing FIR No.0041 dated 08.03.2024 under Sections 363/366/506/34 of IPC registered at Police Station Pinangwa, District Nuh (Haryana) (Annexure P-1).

In compliance of order dated 27.05.2024 passed by this Court, the learned State counsel has filed status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Pardeep Khatri, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana, on behalf of the official respondents-State and the same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that the present petition has become infructuous and she relies upon Annexure R-1 attached with the status report to contend that statement of the prosecutrix was recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. in which she has stated that she is major and she wants to reside with Talim i.e. her husband.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition as the same has become infructuous.
