By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays to quash the order dated 13.02.2024 (Annexure P.4) passed by learned Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, whereby his bail has been cancelled and warrants of arrest have been directed to be issued during the trial of case FIR No.92 dated 22.12 2018 registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Qila Lal Singh, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was on bail in the case and was regularly appearing before the Court. However, on 13.02.2024, he could not appear due to some personal circumstances.

Learned counsel contends that petitioner is ready to surrender before the Court and that he be provided necessary protection.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amandeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State.

This petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 30.05.2024, the date already fixed

there-at, and apply for bail. On his surrender, the Court will proceed against the petitioner under Section 446 Cr.P.C and after disposal of those proceedings, shall admit the petitioner to bail. However, it is made clear that till the disposal of the proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the meantime, petitioner is sought to be arrested in view of the warrants of arrest issued against him, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer.
