NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 25.02.2005 (Annexure P-11), whereby the services of the petitioner have been terminated. Further, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to treat the petitioner in service as per the clarification given by the Punjab Government vide its letter dated 25.07.2005 (Annexure P-14) and to adjust her on the post of Punjab Lecturer.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since despite her best efforts, she has not been able to contact the petitioner, therefore, she does not want to press the present petition. She further submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to revive the



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present petition in case any cause still survives.

3. Dismissed as not pressed with liberty as aforesaid.
