1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.3 and 4 not to interfere in the peaceful and admitted possession of the petitioner and for directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and take appropriate action against respondents No.3 and 4 for illegally restraining the petitioner from entering his land and harvesting the standing crop.

2. At the outset, on oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is impleaded as respondent No.5 in the instant petition. The Registry is directed to amend the memo of parties accordingly.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.5-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the representation dated 22.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

- 5. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.
- 6. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.5-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the representation (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner and take immediate appropriate action, if required, in accordance with law.
