1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to decide the legal notice dated 02.04.2024, Annexure P-8 and to complete the recruitment process and to issue appointment letters to the petitioners in pursuance to Advertisement dated 19.08.2021, Annexure P-3.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since in the recruitment process undertaken in pursuant to Advertisement dated 19.08.2021, Annexure P-3, the result has not been declared without any justification however some appointment letters have been issued to certain candidates as is reflected in letter dated 14.09.2023, Annexure P-7, which is arbitrary. He, on instructions, submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if their legal notice is directed to be decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Swapan Shorey, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has no objection to the limited prayer made.
5. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice of the petitioners, within a period of three months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them, and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress.
