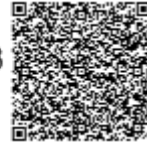

Main Case

1. The respondent-contemnor along with Mr. Arjun Sheoran,
Advocate assisted by Mr. Rohan Gupta, Advocate, has appeared in person.
The contemnor vide his affidavit annexed with CRM-37678-2024, tendered
his unconditional apology.

2. The Court has assessed the demeanor of the contemnor.
Consequently, it has come to the conclusion that the contemnor is
sufficiently humbled, besides is making a soulful atonement in respect of
the purported contempt committed by him. Therefore, this Court is led to

accept his unconditional apology, as it stems from the soul of the contemnor.

3. In consequence, since the contemnor has purged himself of contempt, as such, the contempt petition is closed and the Rule is discharged.

4. Since the main case itself has been decided, thus, all the pending application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
