The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of *mandamus* for directing respondent No.2, to decide the statutory appeal dated 26.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) filed by petitioner, against the order dated 28.07.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.1 for recovery of Rs.1,10,017/- from the retiral benefits of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for deciding the appeal filed by the petitioner dated 26.08.2023 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously by passing a speaking order in a time-bound manner
