1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members.

2. Learned counsel inter alia contends that the petitioner has been receiving continuous threats from anti-nationals and anti-social elements; despite the official respondents having been approached time and again by way of different representations (Annexures P-1 and P-3), they had failed to come to his rescue. Learned counsel has submitted that he would restrict his prayer and will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to take necessary steps in terms of representation dated 29.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, Dy. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the representation dated 29.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law at the earliest.
