KIRTI SINGH, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has become infructuous as the petitioner has been acquitted by the learned trial Court vide order dated 27.02.2024.

However, as per order 12.12.2023, a cost of Rs.20,000/- had been imposed upon the petitioner by a Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Considering the fact that the matter has now been become infructuous, this Court deem it appropriate to reduce the cost from Rs.20.000/- to Rs.10,000/-.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous **subject to payment of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited in the Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh.**

Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
