The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.94 dated 18.03.2024 registered under Sections 17(b) of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Civil Line Sirsa, District Sirsa.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.05.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 20.07.2024 by way of an affidavit of Subhash Chand, Deputy Superintendent of Police (HQ) Sirsa, District Sirsa has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

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Though, the petitioner is an elder brother of the arrested accused, he had joined investigation, at this stage, his custodial interrogation is not required. Therefore, the interim order dated 02.05.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
