1. By way of present second petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, prayer has been made for grant of regular bail pending trial, in case bearing FIR No.124, dated 22.07.2023, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (Sections 22/29 of NDPS Act, added later on), at Police Station Sadar Commissionerate, District Jalandhar.

2. Having argued for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition, however, he prays for issuance of direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. However, considering the fact that the petitioner is behind the bars for a period of more than 07 months and till date charges have not been framed, the Trial Court is requested to expedite the proceedings in the trial

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and conclude the same at the earliest.
