1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.11 dated 21.01.2024, registered under Sections 341, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana.
2. By virtue of order dated 03.05.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. However, learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the contentions raised by counsel for the petitioners.
5. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.
6. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 03.05.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
