This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with prayer for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to get conducted a fair and impartial inquiry at the earliest into the complaints (Annexures P-2, P-4 and P-7) moved by the petitioner to respondent No.2 for taking appropriate legal action against respondent No.5 and other accused mentioned in the said complaints.
