1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation by two different DSPs and ASP in FIR No.0693 dated 29.08.2022 under Sections 313, 323, 34, 406, 498-A and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa, prior to transfer of enquiry to respondent No.3.
2. In compliance of the order dated 07.08.2024, additional affidavit dated 18.11.2024 of Sh. Vikrant Bhushan, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Sirsa has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State in Court today which is ordered to be taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.
3. At the very outset, on instructions from ASI Ompati submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has been substantially redressed. The private respondents have been arrested and investigation has been concluded and supplementary challan under

Section 173 Cr.P.C. (193 BNSS) has been filed on 02.10.2024 before the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sirsa. He further submits that nothing survives in the present petition.

4. In view of the above stand taken by the learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
