Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh, Office of SSP (Rural), Amritsar, submits that the arrears of revised pension have been calculated and the same shall be released in his favour within a period of seven days from today.

[2] In view of the aforesaid stand / undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
