1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for quashing of the order dated 21.09.2016, whereby an application moved before the trial Court for release of passport has been dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the State, at the outset, on instructions from ASI Sukhbir Singh submits that all the prosecution witnesses have already been examined and now the case is fixed for tomorrow for addressing the final arguments before the learned trial Court.
