The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C R/w Section 482 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.63 dated 16.04.2024 registered under Sections 420, 34 IPC at Police Station Anaj Mandi, District Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.07.2024, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 18.07.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
