1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1, 2 and 4 to register the case against respondents No.6 and 7 along with other persons with further prayer for cancellation of FIR No.142 dated 18.07.2018 registered under Section 364-A IPC at Police Station Lambi, District Sri Mukatsar Sahib.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the official respondents to decide representation dated 07.09.2018 (Annexure P-6) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

3. Prayer seems to be justified.

4. Learned State counsel raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

5. In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Mukatsar Sahib, to look into the representation dated 07.09.2018 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 02 (two) weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
