1. The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent to decide the review application dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner.
2. Learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a review application dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent-Board but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the aforesaid review application dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) is considered and decided by the respondent-Board in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. R. S. Budhwar, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. He submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned Senior Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner, he has no objection in case a time bound direction is issued by this Court in this regard.

5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for the reply from the respondent and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent-Board/competent authority to consider and decide the review application dated 22.04.2022 (Annexure P-3), strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
