1. In the present writ petition, the claim of the petitioner is for grant of sports gradation certificate in terms of policy dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P-6).
2. While, considering the claim of the petitioner, Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had passed an order which reads as under:-

“At joint request, the instant case is being segregated from the bunch in which lead case is CWP No.21776-2020.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a copy of application for issuance of sports gradation certificate, which has been received in the office of District Sports Officer, Charkhi Dadri which reflects that petitioner has indeed applied for issuance of certificate.

In the premise, learned State counsel seeks time to get instructions qua status of the aforesaid application. He submits that in case, the petitioner applies and upon

verification it is found genuine, since the Chief Secretary has issued administrative instructions dated 10.05.2022, his case will be processed in terms of the administrative instructions, ibid.

Adjourned to 20.07.2022.”

3. In pursuance to the said order, the respondent has passed an order on 25.11.2022 copy of which has been sent to the Advocate General Haryana wherein, it has been found that the claim of the petitioner for grant of gradation certificate on the basis of participation in Rural Games Federation Cup 2016, Senior (Boys and Girls) held at Venue Kallash Prakash Sports Stadium Saket, Meerut, U.P. from 13.11.2016, has been found to be fake and hence, no gradation certificate can be issued to the candidate in question on the basis of the said alleged Sports participation.
4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to challenge the communication dated 25.11.2022 issued by the District Sports and Youth Affairs Officer, Charkhi Dadri addressed to the Advocate General Haryana, copy of which has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner in Court today.
5. Ordered accordingly.
