Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana and Mr. Harkesh Kumar, AAG, Haryana accept notice on behalf of the respondents.

Counsel for the State has submitted that vide order dated 19.04.2024 passed by the respondent, the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has been complied with. He has also produced a photocopy of the aforesaid order in Court today, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has also been supplied to counsel opposite.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
