1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr.P.C.') seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to transfer the investigation of FIR No.08 dated 28.03.2024 under Sections 354-D, 376, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Women Police Station Mewat, District Nuh.
2. Status report by way of affidavit of Sonakshi Singh, IPS, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Nuh dated 22.05.2024, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record and perusal of its para No.7 indicates that notice under Section 91 Cr.P.C. was issued to the petitioner for producing the audio and video recording, on which

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she is relying upon. However, the petitioner is not cooperating and in the absence of incriminating material, investigating agency is unable to check the veracity of the allegations.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would supply the audio and video recording in her possession, to the investigating agency to substantiate her allegations, within a period of one week from today.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nasheem Akhtar, submits that investigation in the FIR (*supra*) would be taken to logical conclusion and the same will be concluded within a period of three months from today.

5. Disposed of, accordingly.

6. The Investigating Officer would make all possible efforts to conclude the investigation within a period of three months from today.
