1. By way of present petition, the petitioner has sought quashing of orders dated 23.01.2023(Annexure P-11) and 01.04.2023 (Annexure P-12) passed by Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar in captioned FIR whereby non-bailable warrants as well as proclamation proceedings have been issued against him.
2. Mr.Chaudhari submits that since this Court has granted interim protection to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in CRM-M-22845-2024 so now, he does not want to press the present petition and wishes to withdraw the same with liberty to file afresh at the appropriate stage. It is made clear that filing and withdrawal of present petition would not come in



his way in case he seeks similar relief or composite relief by filing fresh petition.

3. State counsel opposes such withdrawal as well as liberty. However, Mr.Chaudhri submits that once there is no adjudication on merits, he has every right to withdraw the petition and file fresh if need so arises in accordance with law.

4. Disposed of as having been withdrawn with liberty to file afresh in accordance with law. Pending application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
