1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that petitioner is suffering from a chronic heart disease, which had already been certified by the medical authorities and keeping in view the said condition, the petitioner has been put on light duty though only for a period of one month.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that once, as per the medical certificate the petitioner is not in a position to drive the Bus and has already been put on light duty, the same should be till the health of the petitioner improves.
3. Notice of motion.



4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that before the expiry of period of one month, appropriate decision will be taken with regard to continuation of the petitioner on the light duty post keeping in view the health status of the petitioner and till, the health of the petitioner improves, he will not be put on duty to drive the Bus so as to endanger not only the life of the petitioner but also the lives of the passengers.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
