Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to the official respondent No. 2 to transfer the investigation of the case FIR (Annexure P-2) to the office of respondent No. 3 from respondent No. 4. Details of the FIR are as under: -

2. Heard.
3. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner, being aggrieved complainant, had lodged

the aforesaid FIR but no action on the same has been taken by the concerned authorities. He submits that even the accused were named in the FIR but till date none of them have joined the investigation and the police is playing partial role in the investigation due to which the petitioner has moved the representation to the higher authorities, latest being Annexure P-5 dated 25.04.2024, moved to the Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector 9, U.T. Chandigarh, but till date the same is still under consideration.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents and submits that the aforesaid representation will be considered and disposed of in accordance with the law.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2 to consider the averments made in the representation dated 25.04.2024 (Annexure P-5), to dispose of the

same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

- 8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
- 9. Disposed of.
