1. In the present petition, the petitioner is challenging the order dated 23.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) by which, the services of the petitioner have been terminated keeping in view the recommendation made by the Committee, according to whom, the attitude of the petitioner is such that the same has created an unhealthy atmosphere in the hospital and all the Staff working in the hospital, where the petitioner is posted, have complaints against the petitioner's working and attitude.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the enquiry report, it has been mentioned that the petitioner should be transferred to some other place but rather than transferring, the petitioner's contract period has been curtailed, which is causing prejudice to her.
3. Notice of motion.



4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the termination of her contract, she can approach the higher authorities with the prayer of transfer and in case, any such claim is raised by the petitioner before the competent authority, the same will be looked into and appropriate order will be passed within a period of four weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed, which will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to approach the higher authorities qua the impugned order raising a claim for transfer instead of curtailing of the contract.
