1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that she would restrict her prayer and will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to expeditiously decide the representation dated 05.04.2024 (Annexure P-3), which was given to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, UT Chandigarh.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Viranjeet Singh Mahal, Addl. PP for UT Chandigarh assisted by Inspector Kehar Singh accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representation dated 05.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law at the earliest, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioner is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.
