1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to issue NOC for operating Retail Outlet for selling of Compressed Bio Gas (CBG).
2. The petitioner claims that he has already created infrastructure for setting up Retail Outlet of CBG. Different Departments have already issued NOC, however, Deputy Commissioner, Jind is sitting over the matter and he is not adjudicating his claim. He has filed multiple representations including legal notice dated 09.03.2024 (Annexure P-55).
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice and waives service and submits that jurisdictional Deputy Commissioner would independently and without being influenced by directions of any other authority, decide application of the petitioner within 8 weeks from today.
