AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Pardeep Kumar [CRM-M-21994-2024] and petitioner Sahil [CRM-M-23901-2024] have filed separate petitions under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.875 dated 22.12.2023 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 427 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Thanesar Sadar, District Kurukshetra. Both petitions are taken up together for hearing and decision at request and with consent of learned counsel for the parties.
2. Brief facts of the case are that Ravinder Pal Singh complainant stated that on 21.12.2023 he along with Surender Singh was going to Kaulapur village on Verna black colour Car bearing No.HR07-AC-4866. At about 7.15 pm



when they reached near farm house of Sahil Khan, Rahul Kumar @ Shanka, Sonu Nain, Sahil Khan, Sahil Fatiraman, Aman, Vicky, Sumit Lather along with 5-7 persons were standing near the gate. Out of them Rahul Kumar @ Shanka and Sonu Nain are attributed with fire gunshot towards them. However, complainant did not receive any injury in this occurrence whereas Surrender fled away towards fields.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner (s) argued that petitioners have joined investigation. They are still ready to cooperate. Therefore, interim bail already granted in their favour may be confirmed. Detailed status reports are taken on record. It is confirmed that present petitioners have joined the investigation.

4. I have considered the facts of the case. Both the petitioners were allegedly present with other co-accused. They are not attributed specific role. Fires were shot by other accused namely Rahul Kumar @ Shanka and Sonu Nain. Petitioners have already joined the investigation. No purpose would be served by putting them behind the bars. Therefore, interim bail already granted vide order dated 07.05.2024 to petitioner Pardeep and order dated 13.05.2024 to petitioner Sahil stand confirmed subject to the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

5. Petitions stand accepted.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
