The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.393 dated 28.10.2022 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 IPC and Sections 66C, 66D, 74 IT Act registered at P.S. Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 05.05.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 05.05.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

The learned Counsel for the complainant submits that the complainant has already received the payment of Rs.1.5 lacs from the

petitioner.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 05.05.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
