The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer to quash the complaint No.207 dated 08.10.2008, under Sections 452, 323 and 143 IPC and all consequential proceedings and judgment of conviction on the basis of compromise dated 15.03.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Vide order dated 16.05.2023, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate on or before 07.06.2023 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise arrived at between the parties and the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate was also directed to submit a report before the next date of hearing.

A report has been received from Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rupnagar and as per the said report, the parties did not appear before the

concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate on or before 07.06.2023 for getting their statements recorded.

In view of the report submitted by the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rupnagar, no further orders are required and the petition is accordingly dismissed.
