1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents not to deduct the amount from the salary of the petitioner during the pendency of the charge-sheet, to refund the amount of recovery from 05/2019 to till date along with interest @ 18% per annum and to provide the details of the shortage of material which has been calculated against the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that without concluding the disciplinary proceedings, the recovery is being effected from the salary of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the disciplinary proceedings pending against the petitioner shall be concluded within a period of 03 months.

4. In this view of the matter, the instant petition is disposed of



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as having become infructuous.

5. However, till the conclusion of the disciplinary proceedings
no recovery shall be effected from the salary of the petitioner.
