VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondent No. 3-AXIS Bank, Branch Khadur Sahib, District Tarn Taran, to release the amount of compensation awarded to the petitioner with respect to the land acquired.
2. It was argued by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the amount in question is not being released in favour of the petitioner on the orders of the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Khadur Sahib, District Tarn Taran.
3. Learned State counsel was directed to seek instructions and to apprise this Court about the claim made by the petitioner.
4. On resumed hearing, learned State counsel submits that there are no orders or instructions that had been issued by the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, to respondent No.3-Bank for non-releasing the amount of compensation in favour of the petitioner.



5. In view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Deepak Pathak, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Khadur Sahib, District Tarn Taran, the dispute if any, is between the petitioner and respondent No.3-Bank, which is not amenable to a writ jurisdiction.
6. Faced with the above situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition at this stage, so as to take recourse to the alternative remediate available in accordance with law.
7. Disposed of as not pressed with the liberty as aforesaid.
