HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite giving grade pay of Rs.4500/- to the petitioner while working as Block Development and Panchayat Officer (BDPO) on current duty charge, the actual benefits have not been released to him by the respondents.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that before the grant of C.D.C charge on B.D.P.O, while working as Accountant, the petitioner was to get grade pay of Rs.3300/- w.e.f 01.01.2006 which has also not been extended to the petitioner, which act on the part of the respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 30.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be

satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 30.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of concerned authorities and is still pending consideration, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
