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**HARKESH MANUJA, J.(Oral)**

1. Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions informs that the proceedings under the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 which are pending consideration before BDPO, Moga shall be concluded within a period of two weeks from today and necessary steps towards its implementation shall be carried out soon thereafter, subject to filing/pendency of any appeal preferred by the affected parties.

2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by learned counsel for the respondent, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

3. Dismissed as not pressed.

4. Rule stands discharged.

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5. However, in case the needful is not done within the  
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be  
at liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality,  
the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay Rs.50,000/- as costs  
from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation  
expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival  
application.
