In view of the orders dated 10.10.2024 and 11.10.2024 passed by the respondents, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.1-DHBVNL has fully complied with the directions issued by the Writ Court, whereas, respondent No.2-UHBVNL has complied with the directions with respect to the inter utility transfer, however, the employees have not been granted their home Districts. In such circumstances, the directions stand complied with.

2. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy regarding the remaining cause, if any survives, in accordance with law. Rule stands discharged.
