1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he would restrict his prayer and will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to look into his representation dated NIL (Annexure P-9) expeditiously and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

4. At the asking of Court, Ms. Trishanjali Sharma, Dy. Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Ambala to look into the representation (Annexure P-9) and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law at the earliest to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.
