1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to take action against respondent No.4 and arrest him, in FIR No.26 dated 31.01.2024 under Sections 363 & 366-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Tibba, District Ludhiana.
2. Learned State counsel appears on advance notice and at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Baljeet Singh, submits that nothing survives in the present petition, as the grievance raised by the petitioner has substantially been redressed. Daughter of the complainant-petitioner has been produced before the jurisdictional Magistrate and her statement under Section 164

Cr.P.C. is recorded. In her statement, she has categorically stated that she wants to live with respondent No.4, who is accused in the FIR (*supra*), and his mother. She further stated that the petitioner-complainant is forcing her to marry with a person much older than her.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
