The prayer in the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.3 to 16.

Notice of motion was issued on 09.05.2024.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 23.05.2024 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Sangrur has been filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

While referring to the said reply, the learned State counsel submits that the statements of the private respondents have been recorded to the effect that they will not interfere in the life of the petitioner. Further,

the petitioner is stated to be residing with her maternal uncle and does not want to take any legal action against the private respondents.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.

Needless to say that in case the petitioner faces any threat to her life in future, she is free to approach the Investigating Agency, which shall take action in accordance with law.
